BICYCLE POLICY

Expectations

- 1. Children under 10 years of age DO NOT ride bicycles to or from school unless accompanied by an adult.
- 2. Skateboards, ripsticks, rollerblades and scooters are not permitted at St Michael's unless directed by teachers.
- 3. Children must correctly wear a Standards Australia approved bicycle helmet at all times when in control of a bicycle.
- 4. All RTA road rules concerning bicycles are to be followed. This includes the pedestrian's right of way on footpaths. The bell should be used as a warning when approaching pedestrians.
- 5. Bicycles ridden to school must be in good, safe working order and bicycles must be fitted with a bell. It is the responsibility of the parent/carer to ensure that the bicycle is in good and safe working order and that all protective equipment as required by law is provided.
- 6. Bicycle riders are expected to use the available pedestrian entry points of the school. These are:
 - The gate in Alice St near the hall
 - The driveway in Alfred St near the Library
- 7. Children are to dismount before entering the school grounds and walk their bicycles whilst on site.
- 8. Bicycles and helmets are brought and stored on school grounds at the owner's risk.
- 9. No riding of bicycles is permitted in school grounds during and after hours
- 10. Parents will be notified if students do not adhere to the school's Bicycle Policy and permission will be withdrawn until the issues identified have been satisfactorily addressed.
- 11. The Principal has the right of discretion to make provision for departure from the policy or the application of the policy in the event of unforeseen and exceptional circumstances.
